

Halifax Independent School Fee Schedule 2012-2013

Primary through Grade 9

Base Fees:

***\$8524 Tuition and \$485 Activity Fee for the first child**

***\$7672 Tuition (a 10% reduction) and \$335 Activity Fee for the second child**

***\$6393 Tuition (a 25% reduction) and \$335 Activity Fee for the third child**

***These prices do not include childcare before or after school.**

If your family is new to the school, please see "Bond", below.

For children entering Grade 7, 8, or 9, there is an additional cost. See the reference to this surcharge, below.

Students requiring ESL support are required to pay a surcharge of \$853 (10% of the Base Tuition Fee).

Hours and Grade Specific information:

Primary through Grade 6

Hours: 9 a.m. - 3:15 p.m.

Children may be dropped off after 8:30 a.m.

Grade 7 through Grade 9

Hours: 8:55 a.m. - 3:35 p.m.

Children may be dropped off after 8:30 a.m.

Middle School students are invoiced a surcharge of \$600 per student.

Bond

Amount: Each family is required to pay a \$1000 bond, with the exception of those participating exclusively in the Littles programme, who pay \$500, and the remaining \$500 upon entering the elementary programme. Only one \$1000 bond per family is required.

Payment Schedule: The bond is purchased in the first academic year of the family's affiliation with the school, with the bond being paid in full by May 1st of that year.

Donating the Bond: As a parting gift to the school, and its future graduates, many families choose to waive the refund of their bond. At some point, while your child is attending the school, you will be asked if you wish to donate all (or, part) of the bond, to the school, which is a registered charity. The donation will be recorded in the year that you would, otherwise, be entitled to receive a refund.

Eligibility for Bond Refund: When your child's enrolment at the school ends, the bond is refundable if your child has attended the school for a minimum of three years.

Bond Refund: Refunds must be requested in writing and are payable in two payments, after settlement of any arrears. The first payment is in December of the academic year following your child's graduation or withdrawal; the second payment in the following June.
