

Fees Schedule 2010-2011

Base Fees for all Grades

***\$7956 Tuition and \$485 Activity Fee for the first child**

***\$7160 Tuition and \$320 Activity Fee for the second child (a 10% reduction in fees)**

***\$5967 Tuition and \$320 Activity Fee for the third child (a 25% reduction in fees)**

***These prices do not include childcare before or after school.**

Grades Primary (“Youngs”) through 6 (“Elders”)

Hours: 9 a.m. - 3:15 p.m.

Children may be dropped off after 8:30 a.m., or as early as 8:00 a.m. if registered for Early Morning Care.

Middle School - Grades 7 through 9

Hours: 8:55 a.m. - 3:35 p.m.

There will be a surcharge of \$400 per student applied to the Base Tuition Fee to cover enrichment activities.

Pre-primary “Littles”

Hours: 9 a.m. - 3:15 p.m., hot lunch included

5 days/wk - *Base Tuition Fee + \$400 lunch

4 days/wk - *\$7320 Tuition + \$320 lunch

Part Days (9 am – 11:45 a.m.) - *\$4680 Tuition (+ optional \$400 lunch, by arrangement)

*This cost does not include Early Morning or After School Childcare.

*The Activity Fee is waived, for Littles

ESL

Students requiring ESL support pay a surcharge of \$796 (10% of the Base Tuition Fee).

Bonds

Each family is required to pay a \$1000 bond, with the exception of those participating exclusively in the Littles programme, who pay \$500, and the remaining \$500 upon entering the elementary programme. Only one bond per family is required.

The bond is purchased in the first academic year of the family's affiliation with the school with the bond being paid in full by May 1st. The bond is refundable if your child has attended the school for a minimum of three years. Refunds must be requested in writing and are payable in two payments. The first payment is in December of the academic year following your child's graduation or withdrawal; the second payment in the following June. At some point during your child's time with us, you will be asked if you wish to donate all or part of the bond to the school, which is a registered charity.

Childcare Programme Fees 2010-11

Afterschool care is available on a regular school days, from dismissal until 5:30 p.m.
Child care is available on Parent –Teacher Conference Days and Inservice Days.
There is no care available during school holidays.

After School Care

The afterschool programme provides many options for supervised, unstructured play. For students in Olds, Elders or Middle School, there is a mandatory, supervised quiet time for reading and homework from 4:30pm – 5 pm (adjusted as daylight becomes precious). Outdoor play is encouraged whenever weather permits. All students must bring their own snack and a drink.

3:15 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.

Your child may attend afterschool only on the days for which they are preregistered. Any other days will be billed at the drop in rate and must be arranged with the childcare coordinator, Megan Colwell.

Rates presume nine monthly payments, September through May.

Early Morning Care

For children pre-registered for afterschool on the same day: free

For all others: \$440 per year/ \$49 per month/\$3 per day

All children arriving between 8 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. must participate in this programme and be supervised in the lunchroom.

Parent Teacher Conference Days/Inservice Days \$30/day

Pre-registration is available to children who are also pre-registered in afterschool care for 4 or 5 days/ week.

All other children will be placed on a waiting list with notice given two weeks before the day.

Full day programme (8:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.)
