

Halifax Independent School Fee Schedule 2011-2012

Base Fees for Youngs – MS2 (Primary through Grade 9):

***\$8275 Tuition and \$485 Activity Fee for the first child**

*\$7448 Tuition (a 10% reduction) and \$335 Activity Fee for the second child

*\$6206 Tuition (a 25% reduction) and \$335 Activity Fee for the third child

***These prices do not include childcare before or after school.**

If your family is new to the school, please see “Bond”, below.

Hours and Grade Specific information:

Youngs (Grade Primary) through Elders (Grades 5 & 6)

Hours: 9 a.m. - 3:15 p.m.

Children may be dropped off after 8:30 a.m.

Middle School - Grades 7 through 9

Hours: 8:55 a.m. - 3:35 p.m.

Children may be dropped off after 8:30 a.m.

Middle School students are invoiced a surcharge of \$400 per student to cover Enrichment activities.

Pre-primary “Littles”

Hours: 9 a.m. – 3:15 p.m., hot lunch included

5 days/wk - *\$8675

4 days/wk - *\$7933

Part Days (9 am – 11:45 a.m.) - *\$4870 Tuition (+ optional \$400 lunch, by arrangement)

***This cost does not include Early Morning or After School Childcare.**

Extend the day to 5:30 p.m. at a cost of \$2475/a (for 5-day Littles), \$2220/a (for 4-day Littles), or \$17 (drop-in daily rate).

Early Arrival Service is \$3 per day, or free for those students already using the after school service.

ESL

Students requiring ESL support pay a surcharge of \$827.50 (10% of the Base Tuition Fee).

Bond

Each family is required to pay a \$1000 bond, with the exception of those participating exclusively in the Littles programme, who pay \$500, and the remaining \$500 upon entering the elementary programme. Only one \$1000 bond per family is required.

The bond is purchased in the first academic year of the family's affiliation with the school with the bond being paid in full by May 1st of that year. The bond is refundable if your child has attended the school for a minimum of three years. Refunds must be requested in writing and are payable in two payments, after settlement of any arrears. The first payment is in December of the academic year following your child's graduation or withdrawal; the second payment in the following June. At some point during your child's time with us, you will be asked if you wish to donate all or part of the bond to the school, which is a registered charity.
